Spring Sale a Success

Thanks to all our members and friends who donated items and or worked at this years spring "garage" sale. Thanks also to those who made baked goods or prepared food for serving to some of our hungry customers/ workers.

We experienced a little hiccup in our sale preparations as we weren't able to get into the civic center for our sale set up until 8:30 p.m. Thursday night due to a scheduling conflict with the center. However, we had a good number of folks turn out and we were pretty well set up and finished by 10:30 p.m. or so. So we were up just a little past our bed times but tired enough to fall right to sleep by the time we got home.

The breakdown of our two day sale is as follows:

Tools and such sold at the senior center---\$1394.00
Baked goods sales---\$281.65

Kitchen sales ---\$137.50
Civic center garage sale items---
\$2,069.40

Total sales for the two day event---
\$3,882.55

Additionally, prior to the sale we sold \$536.00 of merchandise so our total gross revenue was \$4418.55 minus \$60.00 for expenses (dumpster and miscellaneous). Thus our net revenue was \$4,358.55. Way to go everyone!

Twenty seven (27) raffle tickets were sold for the carousel horse. Helen Jackson put her hand in the container and pulled out the winning ticket. The lucky winner was none other than our president June Krause. Congratulations June!

There will be the Linn County Historical Museum which is housed in Brownsville's original railroad depot. It features exhibits and collections dating from pioneer days to the 1940's. We will visit the Moyer House which was built by John Moyer in 1881. The design was inspired by the Italianate Villa style. And we will visit the Living Rock Studio Museum. It is a unique studio with handmade walls embedded with glass and stone. It was built by Howard Taylor and took almost 25 years to complete. Flashlights are provided to see the various rocks light up. There is no set fee here but donations are accepted to keep the place up. Lunch will be on your own. The restaurant has not

been decided on as yet. Bus fee is \$5 and will leave the church parking lot at 10:00 AM.
