## RESERVATIONS

For your enjoyment, all the Dallas city parks are available for use on a first-come, first-served basis, except in the shelter areas in Dallas City Park where there is a seasonal reservation system available from **May 1 – September 30** for the following three areas:

**Brandvold Kitchen Area  
Gazebo**

**Seibert/Frederickson Memorial Shelter**

First priority for reservations in the above-identified areas will be given starting on January 2 to fraternal, civic, patriotic, religious, service, charitable, and educational organizations with a chapter, lodge, post, congregation, or other unit existing within the City. Private groups/family event reservations will be accepted beginning January 15.

All areas will accommodate family reunions, birthday parties, weddings, company picnics, and many other types of gatherings. Each facility is equipped with power, has access to water, and nearby restrooms. The reservation fee is charged hourly. The fee is **\$15.00 and hour**. All fees are figured in whole hour increments.

Special permits are required for use of amplified sound, inflatables such as bouncy castles, tents or dunk tanks, etc.

## SEIBERT/FREDERICKSON MEMORIAL SHELTER



- Large covered area
- Electrical outlets
- 12 picnic tables
- accomodates 150 people

The Seibert Frederickson Memorial Shelter is the newest shelter in the park located next to the recently placed playground equipment and is accessed by means of SW Allgood Street.


## OLD SIDE GAZEBO



- Large covered area
- Electrical outlets
- 6 picnic tables
- accomodates 100 people

The Gazebo located on the Old Side of the Park is accessed through SW Academy Street. It is the oldest shelter in the park and is very rustic and memorable to many park users.

## BRANDVOLD KITCHEN AREA



- Sink
- Hand soap
- Paper towels
- Electrical outlets
- 12 picnic tables
- accomodates 150 people

The Brandvold Kitchen area is accessed via the entrance at 401 SW Levens Street. This uncovered picnic area is an ideal setting for large groups or events with a barbeque, three rows of serving tables (24' long each), 12 picnic tables, and seating for up to 150 people. This is the area used for Rotary Breakfast in the Park during Summerfest, located next to the Japanese Garden, and has nearby restroom facilities.
