## MAYOR'S SPACE

In case you missed it, the Statesman Journal graphically summed up the results of our recent residential street repair bond measure, saying it "crashed and burned." It certainly did, going down 62% against it and 38% in favor. It is hard to improve on their succinct portrayal of the outcome.

My joy in the rubble was the pleasure of being out there visiting with folks, talking about Dallas (virtually everybody loves Dallas) and working my best angles to get them to just vote – any way they wanted. A tiny turnout isn't helpful. A small number of zealots willing to crawl over broken glass to vote emphatically "No" or "Yes" or whatever does not bring clarity. What would we learn from that?

The outcome this time was remarkable. First, as many of you witnessed, I was out there waving my "Please VOTE" sign in heavy traffic for days. That was actually even more fun than it looked largely due to an amazingly positive response from the crowd. Numerous honks, waves, thumbs up and victory signs made my day. Two different cars waved their ballots at me as they passed by. Best of all, it might really have done some good (besides not causing a single wreck!).

Val Unger, our County Clerk, based on her rather extensive experience, was expecting a turnout of about 35% of registered voters for this off-cycle election. As it turned out, her estimate was way short and the County-wide turnout was 51.4%; but Dallas alone was an amazing 57.4%!!

Our society and culture works because of our participation. As Abraham Lincoln said in the worst of our times, "government of the People, by the People, for the People, shall not perish from the earth." Yes, every vote counts, far beyond just the tally. Thank you ever so much for voting and reaffirming our faith in your voice.



**PLAY IN THREE DIFFERENT EVENTS:**

**BOCCIE BALL**  
 The object of the game is to get your balls closest to the palina. The team with the bocce ball closest to the palina is the only one that scores points in a round, and one point is awarded for each ball that is closer to the palina than the opposing team. Two points are given for each ball that touches the palina. The usual goal is 12 points, but this can be changed to create a longer or shorter game.

**CORNHOLE**  
 The object of the game is to throw bean bags and score by landing a bag on the board or through the hole. The points of the low-scoring player are subtracted from the high-scoring player to reach the final point count for the round. This player then starts the throws for the next round from the other platform. The game is played to a point total of 21.

**DISC GOLF**  
 The object of the game is to traverse a course from beginning to end in the fewest number of throws of the disc.  
 This will be a scramble play. Take the best disc.
