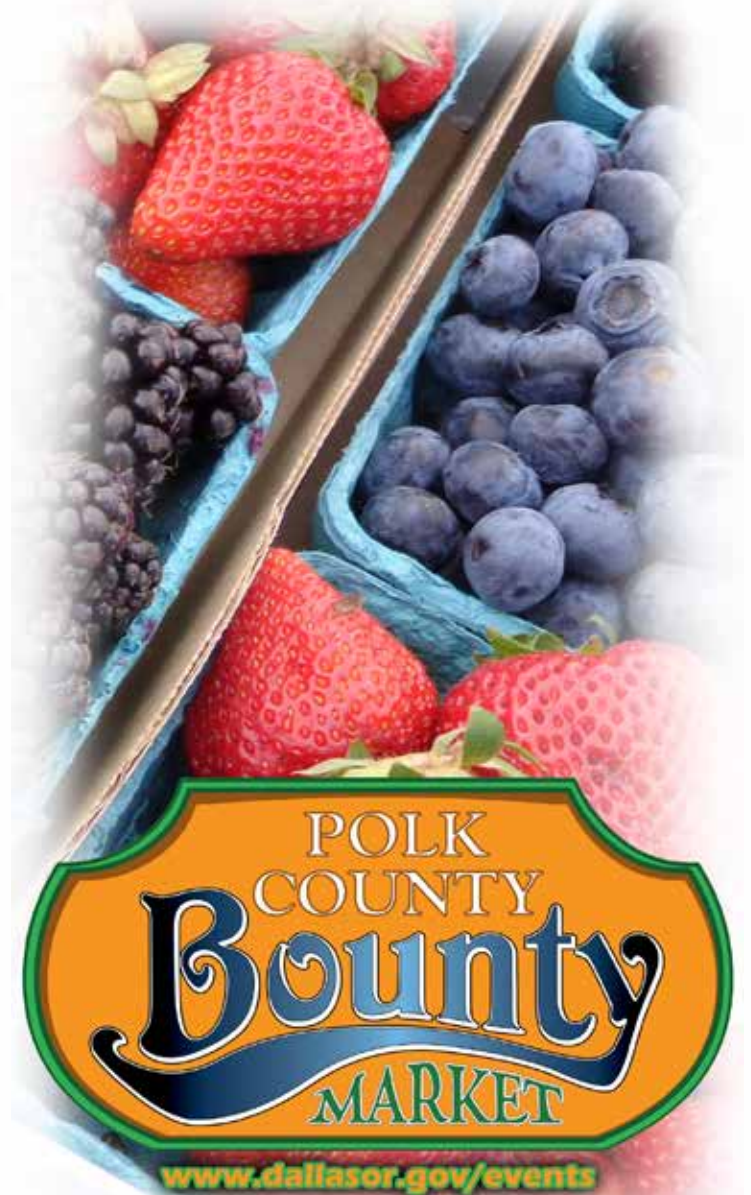


**BOUNTY MARKET**
