RIDE WILDERNESS TRAILS

The **Black Rock trail system** near Dallas is **Oregon's first freeride area for mountain biking**, jointly operated by Oregon Department of Forestry and volunteers. Burma Peak is another top-rated course nearby – not recommended for the meek or inexperienced.

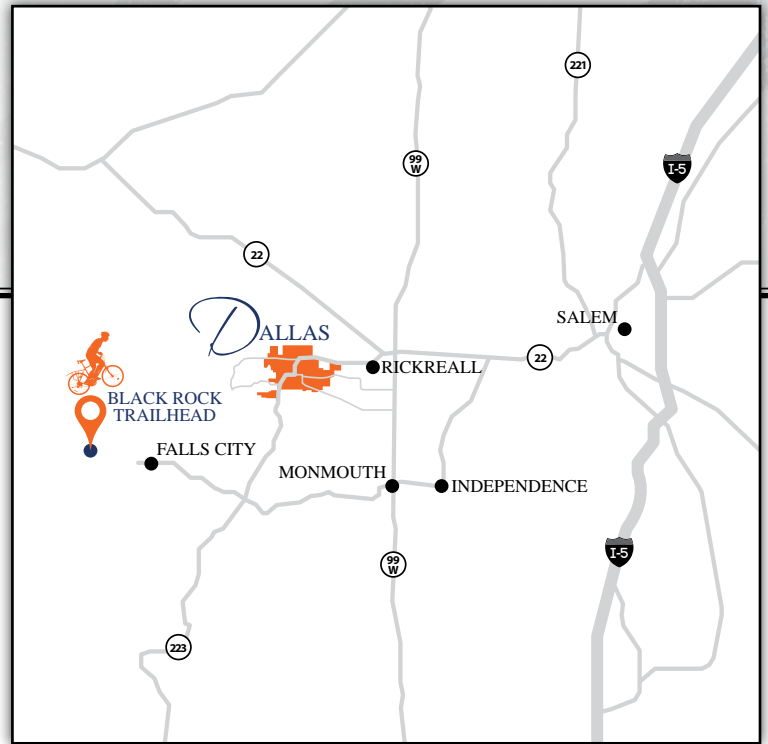
GETTING TO BLACK ROCK

ON INTERSTATE 5, take exit 253 and proceed west through Salem toward Dallas. Continue on Highway 22 west to Dallas: about 9 miles from Salem

- Turn left off Highway 22 on Ellendale Avenue (follow Kings Valley/Falls City signs)
- In Dallas, bear left on Main Street; watch for signs for OR-223 South
- Turn right on Washington Street (becomes OR-223 South)
- Continue south to Falls City: about 9 miles south of Dallas

In Falls City:

- Continue west on main road through town
- Bear right before bridge onto Mitchell
- Continue up short hill; turn left onto dirt road and mark your odometer
- Follow river for 3 miles
- Turn right just past “Camp Tapawingo” sign
- Continue .2 miles, crossing over bridge. Park at small area to the right
- Do not drive past the gate – even if it is open
- Watch for wooden Black Rock Trail signs for details about where to ride. *Have fun!*

Helmet with full face protection, body armor, full fingered gloves
