Save the date, and note these changes

In order to make this truly a recycling event, trash and other non-recyclables will no longer be accepted. Instead, only the following items will be collected:

- Scrap Metal
- Appliances
Microwaves, washers, dryers, etc.
- Yard Debris
branches, trimmings, shrubbery, etc.
- Electronics
TVs, monitors, laptops, computers, printers, keyboards, mice

Polk County Recovery Rate

The 2017 recovery rate for Polk County is **47.4%**. This is up from 2016's rate of 45.9%. The recovery rate is the percentage of total waste generated that is recovered by recycling, composting, or energy recovery, and is calculated by Oregon's Department of Environmental Quality. Keep in mind that recycling is important but greater impacts can be made from reducing waste generated in the first place.

Yard Debris Tips

(Where service exists)

- Only these items should go in the yard debris cart for composting: grass clippings, leaves, brush, branches, tree limbs (smaller than 6" in diameter)
- Place carts at least 5 feet away from other carts, poles, mailboxes, and vehicles
- Make sure the lid closes completely; cut material into smaller pieces if needed
- Do not place trash, metal, plastic, liquids, gravel, rocks or bricks in the yard debris cart
