#### **SELECTION AND TUITION**

#### **APPLICANTS**

Anyone engaged in a career or other endeavors and having an interest in community and growth is invited to apply.

#### SELECTION

Candidates will be selected with a view toward establishing a diverse mix of ages, professions, activities and outlooks as evidenced on the applications. **Class size is limited!** You will be notified of your acceptance into the program in mid-September.

#### **TUITION- \$150.00**

Your tuition fee is due upon notification of selection. This fee supports the costs of the program. Tuition assistance may be available upon request, need and fund availability.

#### ATTENDANCE

Leadership Dallas consists of eight sessions, plus a community service/graduation day. It is vital for both the individual and the class that each member be present to add his or her perspective.

#### METHOD

Approximately 15 Dallas leaders will participate in eight half-day sessions: one the second Thursday of each month from October through May. A graduation event and a Community Service Day in early June will tie together the entire year. Graduates of this class will then be responsible for organizing next year's sessions.
