Application Materials for Round 2 of Downtown ARPA Grants Online

\$100,000 in new grants will be available in 2023 for downtown building improvements

(DALLAS, OREGON) -- Application materials are now available for the City of Dallas 2023 round of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) grants to assist owners of downtown Dallas buildings with key improvement projects. An application form and program guidelines can be now found on the City's website.

The timeline for the 2023 round of funding is listed below. Grant awardees will have 12 months to complete their projects from the time their funding agreements are signed. Applicants are required to provide at least a 2/3 project match investment. Individual grant awards are capped at \$20,000. Prospective applicants are encouraged to discuss their projects with the City's Economic & Community Development Department staff prior to applying to determine eligibility and permits required.
