- BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF OR CONSUME ALCOHOL OR ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES
- LEAVE CHILDREN 10 YEARS AND UNDER UNATTENDED
- BRING INTO THE LIBRARY ANYTHING WHICH CREATES AN OBSTACLE OR TAKES UP SEATING, INCLUDING BICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS, ROLLERBLADES, ROLLERSKATES, CARTS OR LARGE BACKPACKS
- RUN
- TALK OR PLAY AUDIO EQUIPMENT AT A VOLUME WHICH DISTURBS OTHERS
- BE DISRUPTIVE, DISORDERLY, OR HARASS PATRONS AND/OR STAFF
- CONDUCT SURVEYS, OR DISTRIBUTE PRINTED MATERIAL
- PANHANDLE, OR SOLICIT FOR SALES OR CHARITY
- DESTROY, DEFACE OR ABUSE LIBRARY PROPERTY
