#### **MEETING MINUTES**

#### Public Safety Committee Monday, February 26, 2024

#### **APPROVAL OF December 18, 2023 MINUTES**

It was moved by Councilor Shein and seconded by Councilor Schilling to approve the December 18, 2023 minutes. The vote was taken and passed with a vote of 3-0.

#### CITY MANAGER UPDATE

Mr. Latta gave a brief overview of responsibilities the Local Public Safety Coordinating Council (LPSCC). There is one vacancy on the council for an elected official in the district. If any of the committee members are interested they can apply to serve on the council.

#### FIRE DEPARTMENT UPDATE

Chief Wallace gave an overview of current staffing levels. The Fire Department is going to partner with the Dallas High School CTE Program who will potentially be adding an EMR course to the curriculum this Fall. There have been a few issues with the new ASA boundaries and they have been working with SW Polk and 911 to work them out.

#### POLICE DEPARTMENT UPDATE

Chief Simpson gave an overview of current staffing levels and budget preparation. There is a new patrol vehicle currently at the shops waiting for parts. Recently they got approval of an \$83,000 grant for the Emergency Operations Center.
